- 1. Represent qualifications honestly, including education and professional affiliations and provide for the highest quality treatments and techniques possible while only providing those services for which they are qualified to perform.
- 2. Accurately inform clients and the public of the scope and limitations of their discipline.
- 3. Acknowledge the limitations of the profession and seek the best interest of the client.
- 4. Consistently maintain and improve professional knowledge and competence, striving for professional excellence through regular assessment of personal and professional strengths and weaknesses and through continued educational training.
- 5. Conduct business and professional activities with honesty, dignity and integrity, and with respect for the inherent worth of all persons.
- 6. Refuse to unjustly discriminate against clients or other ethical professionals.
- 7. Safeguard the confidentiality between practitioner and client at all times.
- 8. Uphold hygiene and safety standards.
- 9. Commitment to do no harm.
- 10. Abide by the law and the rules and regulations set forth by the Mississippi Legislature and the Mississippi State Board of Barber Examiners.
